This amigurumi is worked with tight stitches and mostly in a spiral pattern, do not close each round unless prompted, you will have to be careful and always mark the start of each lap. Please read the entire pattern before starting.

# This Princess measures approximately 29cm

#### Materials that I have used:

- 100% Mercerized Cotton Yarn 3mm, Colors: flesh color for the skin (890) 66g, Yellow (820) 100g, strong cinnamon (843), white (801), tender pink (827) and lilac (828)
- 100% mercerized cotton yarn 1mm thick, the colors you want for the flowers
- 2.5mm hook Yarn and 2.0mm for the flowers
- Wool needle
- Temporary marker
- Scissors
- 100% hypoallergenic
- padding Silicone tube, 1cm diameter and 12cm long
- Pins
- 10mm safety eyes
- · Blush for her cheeks
- Closure for the dress

## Abbreviations:

R: round

ch: chain

MR: Magic ring

sc: single crochet

hdc: half double crochet

dc: double crochet

dec: decrece (2sc together)

inc: increase (2sc in 1st)

triple inc: increase (3sc in 1st)

hdc inc: Increase (2 hdc in 1 stitch)

dc inc: Increase (2 dc in 1 stitch)

ss: Slip stitch

BLO: Back Loops Only (take back loop only)

FLO: Front Loop Only (take front loop only)

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi bigger or smaller using a thread of greater or lesser thickness and depending on this thread will be the hook number, in the same way you will choose the desired size of the safety eyes and the support for her neck

Enjoy this pattern as much as I did designing it





## Let's start with the body

#### Arms (Make 2)

Flesh color yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2 : 6inc (12)

R3-7: 12sc (60sc total) R8: (4sc, 1dec)x2 (10)

R9-24: 10sc (160sc in total)



Cut yarn at the end of each Arm and Stuff

## Legs (Make 2)

Start with Flesh colored yarn

R1: 4ch, on 2nd start (2sc, 1triple inc)x2

(10)

Note: I suggest you mark Chain number 4 before you start making the first single crochet, because once we work the 2nd repetition on the other side of the chains, right in that 4th chain is where we will do the last triple increase

R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16)

R3: 3sc, 4inc, 4sc, 4inc, 1sc (24)

R4-6: 24sc

R7: 6dec, 12sc (18)

R8: 18sc

R9: 3dec, 6sc, 1dec, 4sc (14) R10-30: 14sc (294sc in total)

In the first leg that you made, you will cut the yarn and in the second leg you will change to soft pink in the last single crochet of the R30 to make the underwear.

You will join the two legs forming a single piece

R31: 9sc on the same leg where you made the color change, 2ch, starting at the 3rd point of the other leg in such a way that both are with the toes facing forward, 14sc, 2sc on the 2ch, 5sc on the leg who started this round (this round will end with 32 points)

R37: (6sc, 1dec) x4 (28) Change to

flech color yarn in the last

decrease of this R

R38: 28sc

R39: (5sc, 1dec) x4 (24)

R40-48: 24sc

R49: 4sc, 10sc in 1 arm, 12sc, 10sc in

another arm, 8sc (44)

Note: You can also secure the strand that was left in the arm.

R51-52: 33sc

R58: 10sc, 1inc (12)





#### Head

R59: 12inc (24)

R60: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30) R61: (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36)

R62: 2sc, linc, (5sc, linc)x5, 3sc (42)

R63: (6sc, 1inc)x6 (48)

R64: 3sc, linc, (7sc, linc)x5, 4sc (54)

R65: 54sc

R66: (8sc, 1inc)x6 (60)


R67: 4sc, linc, (9sc, linc)x5, 5sc (66)

R68: (10sc, 1inc)x6 (72)

R69-77: 72sc

Place the eyes between the R73 and R74 with approximately 13 points of

separation.

Place the silicone tube or the material you want to use to support her head, it may be easier if you make a tip to the silicone, please see the link for more details. You can also place it whenever you want and you consider how to knit more at ease

R78: (10sc, 1dec)x6 (66)

R79-81: 66sc

R82: (9sc, 1dec)x6 (60)

R83: 3sc, 1dec,(8sc, 1dec)x5, 5sc (54)

R84: (7sc, 1dec)x6 (48)

R85: 3sc, 1dec,(6sc, 1dec)x5, 3sc (42)

R86: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36)

Note: After the R86 fill as much as possible so that the filling will firm up the material you placed in the center, if you are using a silicone tube cut it right where the head ends, continue closing with the following rounds and at the same time filling if necessary.





R87: (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30) R88: (3sc, 1dec)x6 (24) R89: (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18) R90: (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12)

R91: 6dec (6)

Close with wool needle

# Ears (Make 2)

R1: MR 5sc

R2: turn, 2sc, 1inc, 2sc (6)

Leave the long thread to sew

to the head.

Place the ears 8sc apart from each safety eye

# Face embroidery

Use white, brown and flesh thread for the nose, enter the link if you need it.









Put blush on her cheeks if you like.

I use blush that is not permanent but if you want to use acrylic blush you can do it

Use yellow yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (1sc, 1inc )x6 (18)

R4: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

R5: 1sc, 1inc, (3sc, 1inc)x5, 2sc (30)

R6: (4sc, linc)x6 (36)

R7: 2sc, linc, (5sc, linc)x5, 3sc (42)

R8: (6sc, linc)x6 (48)

R9: 3sc, 1in, (7sc, 1inc)x5, 4sc (54)

R10: (8sc, 1inc)x6 (60)

R11: 60sc

R12: 4sc, linc, (9sc, linc)x5, 5sc (66)

R13: 66sc

R14: (10sc, 1inc)x6 (72)

R15-20: 72sc

R21-23: 36sc, 36hdc (72)



Green 7ch, in the 2nd start, 1sc, 1hdc, 3dc, 1ss



## Embroider the center

Yellow thread or the one you want

#### Dress

Start with Tender Pink

R1: 37ch, in the 2nd start BLO (5sc,

linc)x6 (42) R2: turn, 42sc



R3: turn, [6sc, (inc: 1hdc, 1dc), 2ch, skip 10 stitches, (inc: 1dc, 1hdc)]x2, 6sc (30) R4-9: turn, 30sc Change to purple



R10: 1ch, turn, BLO 30hdc inc





R11: 1ch, 60hdc, 1ss (60)



R12-20: 1ch, 60hdc, 1ss (60)



Edge White (1ch, 1hdc in the same stitch, we skip a chain, 1ss)x30

R1: 1ch, 1sc in the same stitch, (2hdc, 1hdc inc)x4, 1sc, 1ss (18)

R3: 1ch, 1sc, 20hdc, 1sc, 1ss (22)





R4: 1ch, 5sc, (1hdc, 1hdc dec)x4, 5sc, 1ss (18) Change to color Soft pink
R5: BLO 18ss



R6: BLO 18sc



Close with wool needle
