Important Note:

This amigurumi is worked with tight stitches and mostly in a spiral pattern, do not close each round unless prompted, you will have to be careful and always mark the start of each lap. Please read the entire pattern before starting.

In the description before buying this pattern, I told you that we have a tutorial on our channel to make this amigurumi.

This Princess measures approximately 29cm

Materials that I have used:

- 100% Mercerized Cotton Yarn 3mm, Colors: flesh color for the skin 66g, white and brown for details in her eyes, black, red, Yellow, blue and sky blue
- Hook of 2.5 mm
- Wool needle
- Temporary marker
- Scissors
- 100% hypoallergenic filling
- Silicone tube, 1cm diameter and 12cm long
- Pins
- 10mm safety eyes
- Blush for your cheeks
- Closure for dress

Abbreviations:

R: round

c: chain

MR: Magic ring

sc: single crochet

hdc: half double crochet

dc: double crochet

dec: decrease (close 2 sc together)

inc: Increase (2 sc in 1 stitch)

triple inc: Increase (3 sc in 1 stitch)

hdc inc: Increase (2mpa in 1stitch)

dc inc: Increase (2pa in 1stitch)

ss: slip stitch

FLO: front Loop only

BLO: Back Loops only

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi bigger or smaller using a thread of greater or lesser thickness and depending on this thread will be the hook number, in the same way you will choose the desired size of the safety eyes and the support for her neck

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I do when designing it for you.





Let's start with the body

Arms (Make 2)

Skin color

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3-7: 12sc (60sc in total)

R8: (4sc, 1dec)x2 (10)

R9-24: 10sc (160sc in total)



Cut The end of each Arm and Fill

Legs (Make 2)

Start with Flesh colored yarn

R1: 4ch, in the 2nd start (2sc, 1triple

inc)x2 (10)

Note: I suggest you mark Chain number 4 before starting to make the first single crochet, because once we knit the 2nd repetition on the other side of the chains, right in that 4th string is where we will do the last triple increase

R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16)

R3: 3sc, 4inc, 4sc, 4inc, 1sc (24)

R4-6: 24sc

R7: 6dec, 12sc (18)

R8: 18sc

R9: 3dec, 6sc, 1dec, 4sc (14)

R10-30: 14sc (294sc in total)

In the first leg that you made, you will cut the strand and in the second leg you will change to Yellow in the last single crochet of the R30 to make the underwear.

You will join the two legs forming a single piece

R31: 9sc on the same leg where you made the color change, 2ch, starting at the 3rd point of the other leg in such a way that both are with the toes facing forward, 14sc, 2sc on the 2ch, 5sc on the leg who started this round (this round will end with 32 points)



R79-81: 66sc

R82: (9sc, 1dec)x6 (60)

R83: 3sc, 1dec,(8sc, 1dec)x5, 5sc (54)

R85: 3sc, 1dec,(6sc, 1dec)x5, 3sc (42)

R86: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36)

Note: After the R86, fill as much as you can so that the filling gives firmness to the material that you placed in the center, if you are using a silicone tube, cut it just where the head ends, continue closing with the following turns and at the same time filling if you think it is necessary.

R90: (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12)

R91: 6dec (6)

Close with wool needle



Ears

R1: MR 5sc

R2: turn, 2sc, linc, 2sc (6)

Leave the long thread to sew to

the head.

Place the ears 8 sc apart from

each safety eye

Start with Black thread

R1: RM 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R4: (2sc, linc)x6 (24)

R5: 1sc, 1inc, (3sc, 1inc)x5, 2sc (30)

R6: (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36)

R7: (5sc, linc)x6 (42)

R8: (6sc, 1incx6 (48)

R9: (7sc, 1inc)x6 (54)

R10: (8sc, 1inc)x6 (60)

R11: 60sc

R12: (9sc, linc)x5 (66)

R13: 66sc

R14: (10sc, linc)x6 (72)

R15-20: 72sc

R21-23: 36sc, 36hdc (72)

Isc and then Cut leaving a long thread and then sew to the head after making the locks.

Black yarn

Start at point 17 from the inside out, BLO [50ch, in the 2nd start, 1sc, (1hdc, 1inc hdc)x24, 1ss] x4 Hide the strands that have remained.

Red color yarn

R1: 3ch, on the 2nd start, 2sc (2)

R2-38: turn, 2sc

Cut strand leaving to sew the hair

1ss, 30sc

R2-5: BLO 30sc

R1: 37ch, in the 2nd start (5sc, linc)x6

(42)

R2: turn, 42sc

R3: turn, [6sc, (inc: 1hdc, 1dc), 2ch,

jump 10 stitches, (inc: ldc, lhdc)]x2,

6sc (30)


Edge

White color yarn

Make a slipknot, insert the hook into the stitches you choose to start and extract this slipknot BLO (1ch, 1hdc in the same point, we skip a point, 1ss in the next point) x60 Secure with a wool needle.

Start with Sky Blue Prepare a slip knot

R1: 1ch, 1sc in the same point, then continue the base of dc inc and hdc of R3 (2hdc, 1hdc inc)x4, 1sc, 1ss to close each Round (18)



White, Prepare a slip knot, 2ch starting at the same base (4dc, 1dc inc)x3, 2ch, 6ss, 2ch, (1dc inc, 4pa)x3, 2ch 1ss in the same base.
