Important note:

This amigurumi is worked with well-
adjusted stitches and for the most part in a
spiral shape, do not close each round
unless I tell you to, you will have to be
careful and always mark the beginning of
each round. Please read the entire pattern
before beginning.

on our channel to make this amigurumi.

These amigurumis measure approximately 15-17cm

Materials:

- Sinfonia yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton, measures approximately 3mm thick and has 6 strands. Colors: Pumpkin (Orange), Intense Olive (Dark Green), Fresh (Light Green), Strong Cinnamon, White and flesh or skin.
- Hook 2.5mm
- 100% acrylic yarn for beard and hair
- Wool Needle
- Temporary marker
- Scissors
- Stuffing for amigurumis
- Pins
- hot silicon
- 6 pipe cleaners or wire (19cm each)
- 3 marbles or buttons (colors of your choice)

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi larger or smaller using a thicker or thinner yarn and depending on this yarn the hook number will be. In the same way you choose, you must take into account the size of the buttons.

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I do.
when designing it for you.

Abbreviations:

A: Round
ch: chain
MR: Magic Ring
sc: single crochet
dec: decrease (close 2sc together)
inc: Increase (2 sc in 1 stitch)
dc: double crochet
hdc: half double crochet
ss: slip stitch
FLO: Front Loop Only (take only the front loop)
BLO: Back Loop Only (take only the back loop)



Body (x2)

Use Fresco colored thread and another intense Olive color

R1: MR 8sc

R2: 8inc (16)

R3: (1sc 1inc)x8 (24)

R4: (2sc, 1inc)x8 (32)

R5-19: 32sc

Note: when finishing R10 it is necessary to arrange the fabric and place it on a flat surface to melt silicone, then let it cool and when it is hard continue the following rounds

R20: (2sc, 1dec)x8 (24)

R21: 24sc

R22: (1sc, 1dec)x8 (16)

R23: 16sc

Fill and close with wool needle

Arms (x4)

Start using pumpkin-colored yarn for all 4

R1: MR 6sc

R2: (1sc, 1inc)x3 (9)

R3: 9sc

R4: 4sc, 4hdc on the same base and closed together, 4sc (9)

R5-6: 9sc Change to Fresco color on two arms and intense Olive on the other 2.

R7: BLO 9sc

R8-15: 9sc

R16: 4sc closing (see video)

Leave a long thread for the union with the body, these arms do not need padding, make sure when arranging the fabric that the finger is on one side.

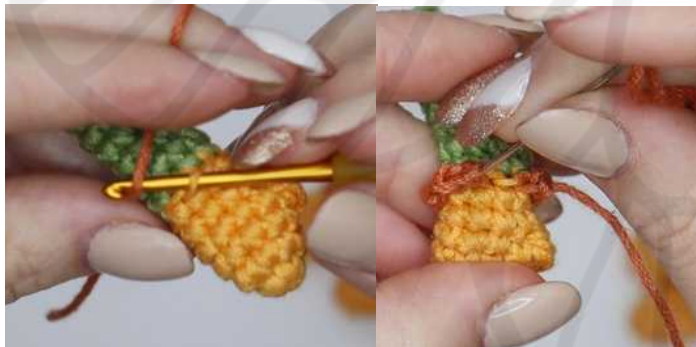

Use the strong tan thread and work on the strands that were free from the R6.

Use pumpkin colored thread.

R1: MR 6sc

R2-4: 6sc

R5: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)

R6-9: 8sc

R10: (3sc, 1inc)x2 (10)

R11-14: 10sc

R15: (4sc, 1inc)x2 (12)

R16-17: 12sc

R18: (3sc, 1inc)x3 (15)

R19-20: 15sc

R21: (4sc, 1inc)x3 (18)

R22-23: 18sc

R24: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

R25-26: 24sc

R27: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)

R28: 30sc

R29: (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36)

R30: 36sc

R31: 2sc, 1inc, (5sc, 1inc)x5, 3sc (42)

R32-33: 42sc

R34: FLO 42sc

R35: (1ch, 1ss)x42

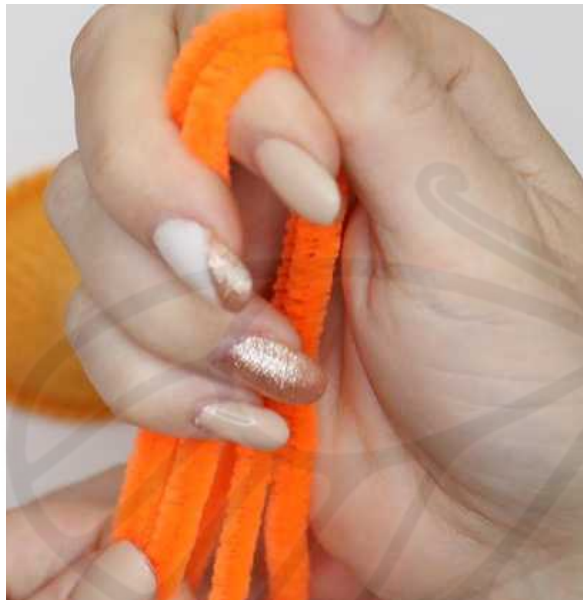
Close with a wool needle and leave a long thread for joining with the body. (watch video)

To twist the tip of the hat it is necessary to use pipe cleaners or wire, do so just before joining it to the body, this union will be made by taking the free strands that remain inside the hat. Use 3 pipe cleaners of approximately 19cm each, fold them in half and twist them

Nose (x2)

Use flesh or skin colored thread

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (5sc, 1inc)x2 (14)

R4: 14sc

R5: 7dec (7)

Cut, leaving the long thread to join the body, fill and close with a wool needle.

Pumpkin

Use pumpkin colored yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R4: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

R5-6: 24sc

R7: (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18)

R8: 18sc

R9: (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12)

R10: 12sc

Close using wool needle.

Note: Close leaving the long strand to form the pumpkin

Stem

Use tobacco colored thread

5ch, in the 2nd start BLO 4sc

Join to the center of the pumpkin.

Note: When finished, leave the long thread to attach this piece to the pumpkin (see video)

Note: Attach to the hat leaving the desired length

Counting from top to bottom, place your arms between R3 and R4 and ensure that one is on each side with the fingers located in the same direction. With a thread of the same color that has been used for the gloves (red) fix the arms only if desired. Watch video for greater understanding.

For hair and beard use 100% acrylic yarn and pet comb (see video for greater understanding)

Place the nose between R4 and R5 counting from the top, right between the bows
