# Important note:

This amigurumi is worked with welladjusted stitches and for the most part in a spiral shape, do not close each round unless I tell you to, you will have to be careful and always mark the beginning of each round. Please read the entire pattern before beginning.

# Amber is approximately 30cm tall.

## Materials:

- Sinfonia yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton, measures approximately 3mm thick and has 6 strands. Colors: Flesh or skin 890 (70g), White 801, Tobacco 888, Strong Cinnamon 843, Bordeaux (Red) 90g
- 2.5mm hook for Symphony yarn
- Wool Needle
- Scissors
- 10mm safety eyes
- Temporary marker
- Pins
- Silicon stick (glue)
- Stuffing for amigurumis
- 1 2.5cm button, 1 medium button and
- 2 marbles or pearls.

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi larger or smaller using a thread of greater or lesser thickness and depending on this thread will be the hook number, in the same way you will choose the desired size of the safety eyes

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I did designing it for you.



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R: Round c: chain AM: Magic Ring

Abbreviations:

sc: single crochet dec: decrease (close 2 sc together) inc: increase (2 sc in 1 stitch) triple inc: increase (3sc in 1st) hdc: half double crochet FLO: Front Loop Only BLO: Back Loops Only



Let's start with the body Arms (x2) Use flesh-colored yarn or the one you choose for the skin R1: MR 6sc R2: 6inc (12) R3-4: 12sc R5: 5sc, (bobble stitch: 4hsc closed together in the same place), 6sc (12) R6: 12sc R7: (4sc, 1dec)x2 (10) R8-24: 10sc

Cut strand at the end of each Arm and Fill in just a little

## Legs (x2)

Start with flesh-colored yarn or whatever you have chosen for the skin.

R1: 4ch, in the 2nd start (2sc, 1 triple inc)x2 (10) Note: I suggest you mark Chain number 4 before starting the first single crochet, because once we knit the 2nd repeat on the other side of the chains, that 4th chain is where we will do the last triple increase

R8: 6dec, 12sc (18) R9: 18sc R10: 3dec, 6sc, 1dec, 4sc (14) R11-30: 14sc Change to yarn color White

In the first leg that you made, you will cut the thread and in the second leg you will change to White color yarn in the last single crochet of the R30 to make the underwear

R31: 2ch, 14sc in the other leg, 2sc in the 2ch, 14sc in the leg that started this R. (32) https://youtu.be/ghCHRBViVk8?t=1196



R32-36: 32sc R37: (6sc, 1dec)x4 (28) Change to Flesh color on the last decrease of this R

R38: 28sc R39: (5sc, 1dec)x4 (24) R40-48: 24sc







R49: 9sc, 10sc in one arm, 12sc, 10sc en el otro brazo, 3sc (44)



Note: Place Marker on each side, right where you marked is where you will join the arms.

R50: (2sc, 1dec)x11 (33) R51-52: 33sc R53: (1sc, 1dec)x11 (22) R54: 22sc

R78: (10sc, 1dec)x6 (66) R79-81: 66sc Place the eyes between R73 and 74 with approximately 13 points of separation



## Ears (x2)

We will make the ears with 8 points of separation from each eye

In their points they will be the same, the different thing will be where to start each one

1ch, 1sc, 5hdc in the same stitch, 1sc, 1ss

R82: (9sc, 1dec)x6 (60) R83: 3sc, 1dec, (8sc, 1dec)x5, 5sc (54) R84: (7sc, 1dec)x6 (48) R85: 3sc, 1dec, (6sc, 1dec)x5, 3sc (42) R86: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36) https://youtu.be/36wJfsYwM8k?t=1724



Note: I have introduced the silicone once more, to cut it and be able to fill



R87: (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30) R88: (3sc, 1dec)x6 (24) R89: (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18) R90: (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12) R91: 6dec (6) Close with a wool needle See the link and you will understand how we close our amigurumis







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## Hair

Use strong tan color yarn and tart with 1slip knot

[54ch, in the 2nd star (1hdc, 1hdc inc)x10, 32hdc, 1sc]x20

Ich to secure and cut the strand, no length is needed, glue or sew the hair with a finer strand, it is always recommended to sew for greater security.

Hat Use burgundy (red) thread

Note: It is very important that you use red yarn, although the following images are with an intense olive color, but it is exactly the same pattern.

In all rounds you will make 1ch of rise and the next point will begin at the base of the same, always the pd will do it at the end in the first mp of said round.

R1: MR, 1ch, 8hdc, 1ss (8)



R2: 1ch, 8hdc, 1sc (16)

R11: 1ch, (8hdc, 1hdc inca)x8, 1ss (80) R12: 1ch, 80hdc reverse, 1ss (80) R13: 1ch, 80hdc, 1ss (80) R14: 1ch, 80hdc reverse, 1ss (80) R15: 1ch, 80hdc, 1ss (80)

Start using Bordeaux Red thread and start with 1 slip knot.

R9: 1ch, turn, BLO 30hdc inc(60) https://youtu.be/kV7tHXZyTeo?t=167



R10: 1ch, turn, (3hdc, 1hdc inc)x15, 1ss (75) https://youtu.be/kV7tHXZyTeo?t=237



R11-21: 1ch, 75hdc, 1ss(75) Change to white thread in the last sc of R21. https://youtu.be/kV7tHXZyTeo?t=322



R22: 1ch, 75sc, 1ss (75) R23: FLO (1ch, 1ss)x75 Secure and hide the thread using a wool needle. https://youtu.be/kV7tHXZyTeo?t=382

Start using Bordeaux Red tcolor yarn
Start with 1 slip knot.
R1: 25ch, in the 2nd start 24sc (24)
R2: turn, (5sc, 1inc)x4 (28)
R3: turn, (6sc, 1inc)x4 (32)
R4: turn, (7sc, 1inc)x4 (36)
R5: turn, (8sc, 1inc)x4 (40)
R6: turn, (9sc, 1inc)x4 (44)
R7-10: turn, 44sc (44)
R11: turn, (1sc, 1inc)x22 (66)
Ich to secure and cut the thread



Start the next round using white thread (see video)

R12: 1ch, 10sc, 1 triple inc, 64sc, 1 triple inc, 11sc, 24ch

Cut the thread, leaving enough thread to later join some detail.

R1: 4ch, in the 2nd beg (2sc, 1 triple inc)x2 (10) R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16) R3: (2sc, 6inc)x2 (28) R4: BLO 28sc (28)



R5-8: 28sc (28) R9: 2sc, 6dec, 14sc (22) R10-12: 22sc (22) Change to White yarn in the last sc of R12. R13: 22sc (22) R14: FLO (1ch, 1ss)x22 Close using lamprey needle (see video) https://youtu.be/MBE2U0ise3c?t=333



Bow (x2) MR (3ch, 2dc, 3ch, 1ss)x2 Delard the long strand to make the center of the bow (see video) https://youtu.be/MBE2U0ise3c?t=419
