Important note:

This amigurumi is worked with welladjusted stitches and for the most part in a spiral shape, do not close each round unless I tell you to, you will have to be careful and always mark the beginning of each round. Please read the entire pattern before beginning.

Amber is approximately 30cm tall.

Materiales:

- Hilaza Sinfonia 100% Algodón Abbreviations: Mercerizado, mide aproximadamente 3mm de grosor y tiene 6 hebras. Colores: Carne o piel 890 (70g), R: Round Blanco 801, Tabaco 888, c: chain Canela Fuerte 843, Rosa 810 AM: Magic Ring Gancho de 2.5mm para hilaza Sinfonía sc: single crochet Aguja Lanera dec: decrease (close 2 sc together) Tijera inc: increase (2 sc in 1 stitch) • Ojos de seguridad de 10mm triple inc: increase (3sc in 1st) Marcador temporal hdc: half double crochet Alfileres FLO: Front Loop Only Barra de Silicon (pegamento) **BLO: Back Loops Only** Relleno para amigurumis
 - Velcro (cierre de la blusa)
 - Rubor para las mejillas y orejas
 - Alambre (para la diadema)

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi larger or smaller using a thread of greater or lesser thickness and depending on this thread will be the hook number, in the same way you will choose the desired size of the safety eyes

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I did designing it for you.







Let's start with the body Arms (x2) Use flesh-colored yarn or the one you choose for the skin R1: MR 6sc R2: 6inc (12) R3-4: 12sc R5: 5sc, (bobble stitch: 4hsc closed together in the same place), 6sc (12) R6: 12sc R7: (4sc, 1dec)x2 (10) R8-24: 10sc




Cut strand at the end of each Arm and Fill in just a little

Legs (x2)

Start with flesh-colored yarn or whatever you have chosen for the skin.

R1: 4ch, in the 2nd start (2sc, 1 triple inc)x2 (10) Note: I suggest you mark Chain number 4 before starting the first single crochet, because once we knit the 2nd repeat on the other side of the chains, that 4th chain is where we will do the last triple increase

R8: 6dec, 12sc (18) R9: 18sc R10: 3dec, 6sc, 1dec, 4sc (14) R11-30: 14sc Change to yarn color White

In the first leg that you made, you will cut the thread and in the second leg you will change to White color yarn in the last single crochet of the R30 to make the underwear

R31: 2ch, 14sc in the other leg, 2sc in the 2ch, 14sc in the leg that started this R. (32) https://youtu.be/I1-HpjU3zGk?t=1280



R32-36: 32sc R37: (6sc, 1dec)x4 (28) Change to Flesh color on the last decrease of this R

R38: 28sc R39: (5sc, 1dec)x4 (24) R40-48: 24sc











R49: 9sc, 10sc in one arm, 12sc, 10sc en el otro brazo, 3sc (44)



Note: Place Marker on each side, right where you marked is where you will join the arms.

R50: (2sc, 1dec)x11 (33) R51-52: 33sc R53: (1sc, 1dec)x11 (22) R54: 22sc

R55: 11dec(11) R56-57: 11sc R58: 1inc, 10sc (12)



R60: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30) R61: (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36) R62: 2sc,1inc, (5sc, 1inc)x5, 3sc (42) R63: (6sc, 1inc)x6 (48) R64: 3sc, 1inc, (7sc, 1inc)x5, 4sc (54) R65: 54sc R66: (8sc, 1inc)x6 (60) R67: 4sc, 1inc, (9sc, 1inc)x5, 5sc (66) R68: (10sc, 1inc)x6 (72)

R78: (10sc, 1dec)x6 (66) R79-81: 66sc Place the eyes between R73 and 74 with approximately 13 points of separation



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Ears (x2)

We will make the ears with 8 points of separation from each eye

In their points they will be the same, the different thing will be where to start each one

1ch, 1sc, 5hdc in the same stitch, 1sc, 1ss




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R82: (9sc, 1dec)x6 (60) R83: 3sc, 1dec, (8sc, 1dec)x5, 5sc (54) R84: (7sc, 1dec)x6 (48) R85: 3sc, 1dec, (6sc, 1dec)x5, 3sc (42) R86: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36) https://youtu.be/ohet1sIsWmk?t=1750



Note: I have introduced the silicone once more, to cut it and be able to fill



R87: (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30) R88: (3sc, 1dec)x6 (24) R89: (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18) R90: (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12) R91: 6dec (6) Close with a wool needle

Hair

Use strong tan color yarn and tart with 1slip knot

[54ch, in the 2nd star (1hdc, 1hdc inc)x10, 32hdc, 1sc]x20

Ich to secure and cut the strand, no length is needed, glue or sew the hair with a finer strand, it is always recommended to sew for greater security.

Diadem


Use white thread R1: MR 6sc R2-50: 6sc Close with wool needle, before placing wire.

Cut the wire according to the length of the previous piece, it must be a wire that when placed on the head maintains the desired curvature.

Ears (x2)

Use white color yarn R1: MR 6sc R2: (1sc, 1inc)x3 (9) R3: (2sc, 1inc)x3 (12) R4: (3sc, 1inc)x3 (15) R5: (4sc, 1inc)x3 (18) R6-10: 18sc R11: (4sc, 1dec)x3 (15) R12: 15sc R13: (3sc, 1dec)x3 (12) R14-16: 12sc



Close with a wool needle joining one side to the other and then with a double stitch that base, leaving a thread to join each ear to the previous piece. Add blush to taste. https://youtu.be/Fp6IWWAWI3k?t=560

Start using pink thread Start with 1 slip knot. R1: 4ch, in the 2nd start (2sc, 1triple inc)x2 (10) R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16) R3: (2sc, 6inc)x2 (28)

Shoe ears (x2)

Start with 1 slipknot and white thread. (6ch, in the 3rd beg BLO 2hdc, 1sc, 1ss)x2 Leave the long thread at the beginning and at the end to attach to the shoe, in the front of each shoe and as centered as possible between rounds 9 and 10.

Skirt

Start with 1 slip knot. and pink thread for the waist R1: 5ch, in the 2nd start BLO 4ss (4) R2-46: 1ch, turn, 4ss (4) Close with wool needle https://youtu.be/_aEliBWh5nk?t=31

R1: 1ch, in the same base begin 23hdc inc, 1ss (46) https://youtu.be/_aEliBWh5nk?t=306



R2: 1ch, 46hdc (46) R3: 1ch, FLO 46hdc (46) Change to pink color yarn R4: (1ch, 1ss)x46.

Extra ruffles

Start with white color yarn R1: 1ch, BLO 46hdc (46) R2: 1ch, 46hdc (46) R3: 1ch, FLO 46hdc (46) Change to pink color, do not cut the white strand if you want to continue making ruffles. R4: (1ch, 1ss)x46.

Blouse



Use white color yarn R1: 31ch, in the 2nd start 30sc (30) R2-4: turn, 30sc (30) (30) R5: turn, 8sc, 13ch, skip 1st, 12sc, 13hc, skip 1st, 8sc (54) R6: turn, 9sc, 2hdc, 7dc, 2hdc, 14sc, 2hdc, 7dc, 2hdc, 9sc (54) R7: 54sc Change to pink color yarn R8: turn, ss all around the edge of the blouse, make a chain to close the piece. https://youtu.be/_aEliBWh5nk?t=1313
