Important Note:

Please read the entire pattern before you begin knitting to familiarize yourself with the instructions and construction.

For this hat, it's important to maintain proper tension to achieve the final size. This project is worked in the round; unless otherwise indicated, each round will be closed with a slip stitch (sl st) and the next round will begin with a turning chain (ch). If you have any questions about the stitches, please refer to the tutorial on our YouTube channel, GretaWings Plus, and use the links provided to go directly to the video section you need. If you find any errors or need help with the pattern, please contact me.

"Versatile Size: Although the initial circumference is designed for a 5-year-old child, the stitching technique used in this hat maximizes its elasticity. This allows the same pattern to comfortably fit the head of a teenager or even an adult, offering exceptional adaptability."

MATERIALS:

- We used 100% acrylic braided wool of approximately 3mm, in a variegated color,
- with 4.00mm hook
- Needle to work
- Scissors

ABBREVIATIONS:

- R: Round
- ch: chain stitch
- MR: Magic ring
- sc: single crochet
- dec: decrease (close 2 sc together)
- inc: Increase (2sc in 1 stitch)
- dc: double crochet
- hdc: half double crochet
- ss: Slip stitch
- FLO: Front Loop Only (take only the front strand)
- BLO: Back Loop Only (take only the back strand)

Size Adjustment Tips

This pattern is highly adaptable, allowing you to create hats for any size, from newborn to adult. The key to adjusting the size lies in just one factor: the starting diameter.

Material Adjustment:

If you decide to use a thinner or thicker yarn, adjust the hook size accordingly. Remember that a thicker yarn will make the hat larger even if you follow the same number of rounds.

I hope you enjoy designing and adapting this pattern to your needs as much as I enjoyed creating it. Happy knitting!

While working the last few half double crochets (hdc) of this round, you can work into the starting yarn (weaving it in). Then, when you cut and secure it, the base of your scarf will have a cleaner, neater finish. If you prefer, this step is optional, and you can always weave in the yarn later with a tapestry needle.

Start with 1 slip knot

R1: 80ch, on the 1st ch of the beginning

BLO 1ss, 2ch, 79hdc, 1ss closing (80)

R2-4: 2ch, (1hdc-right, 1hdc-reverse)x39, 1hdc-right, 1ss (80)

Points in Relief (Important):

If this is your first time working with relief stitches (knit and purl), we highly recommend watching the video tutorial we've shared via the link. It's essential! A clear understanding of this technique ensures you achieve the characteristic elasticity and texture of the scarf's ribbed crochet. [Link to video](#)



R2-4: 2ch, (1hdc-right, 1hdc-reverse)x39,
1hdc-right, 1ss (80)

R5: 3ch, in each hdc-right perform
1inc-dc-right,
1ss in the 1st back stitch (80)

R6: 2ch, BLO 79hdc, 1ss (80)

The hat's texture is achieved by working only in a special loop that is NOT the traditional back loop (BLO). Please refer to the video tutorial or the links attached to this round to identify the correct loop where you should insert your hook.

R14: 2ch, BLO (1hdc-dec, 1ch)x39,
1hdc closed together with the ch's at the beginning

the next ch)x39, 1ss to close
